Preamble:

There is a need of separate faculties for B.V.A. Bridge Course (Painting) in Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur.

Necessity of Bridge Course:

There are only 4 or 5 Districts in Maharashtra were Post Graduated Courses of Visual Art / Fine Art conducted in Maharashtra state, considering the importance of post graduate studies in Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur Started professional Post Graduate Degree in Master of Visual Art- Painting (M.V.A. - Ptg.) from the academic session 2023-24 to take admission in the post graduate course of M.V.A. (Ptg.). B.V.A. Degree is prerequisite, however, it may be observed that there are a very few Fine Arts University / colleges in state of Maharashtra that offer BVA degree course where as there as large number of institution in the state, which offer Five years G.D. Art (Drawing & Painting) or equivalent course. In order to provide access to post graduate studies for students who obtain G.D. Art or its equivalent need to study bridge course to get qualified for seeking admission in M.V.A. to make them as per with B.V.A. degree.

Aim & Objectives of Course:

To create opportunities for students having G.D. Art or its equivalent diploma to pursue post graduate degree of M.V.A. in their respective field of specialization in Creative Painting or Portraiture.

One Year / Two Semesters in B.V.A. Bridge Course (Drawing & Painting) is to provide the student with training in the skills for original and creative visual expression. It is planned with the conviction that the technical competence provides the most satisfactory foundation for creative expression. Yet mastery of the technique is only the means, not the end. Painting is the visual expression of experience, thoughts and dreams which stimulate one's vision to new realities. It is intended that the students are exposed to all schools, traditions, techniques and media of painting practiced from the early to the modern times. The course would seek to cultivate in the student an individual personality and professional responsibility.

Admired and extolled by many, but equally misunderstood and divided by some others, are the Culture, Religion & Arts and Traditions of the Bharatiya.
