## Student Scholarships and Freeships Provided by University

Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur is a public state university and recognized under 2F & 12 B by UGC. The university follows all the respective rules and regulations for offering Government Scholarships to all Students. Apart from this university provides various scholarships, fellowships and incentives to the students on the basic of their performance and merit in academic, cultural, social and sports at national and international level. These details of all scholarships provided by the university are as follows

- 1) The University is providing fee concession/fee waiver for needy students of all courses. A standard procedure is followed for the same.
  - The students who are intending to avail this facility have to submit their application in a prescribed format to the Director of the School. The applications can be collected from the university Library.
  - The Director of the School based on the applicant's academic performance and the economic background scrutinize the application and the same is discussed in the school faculty council.
  - The recommendation of the school faculty council is forwarded to the Vice -Chancellor by the Director of the School.
  - The Vice Chancellor presents the same in the Management council meeting and the final approval and rejection of the same happens.
  - Usual submission of the application happens in February/March before the academic year.
  - Begins in the case of already enrolled students and June/ July for First year students.
  - Management council consists of the Vice Chancellor, Registrar, Director and Head of the Department.
- 2) The University is also providing Merit Scholarships for the academically excellent students from all the batches and courses. Exam Department will provide the data of the students and the students are awarded the cash prizes from each batch.
- 3) University also provides the academic scholarships for those students who excel in UGC NET and SET exams as well as other competitive exam.



## Policy to Nurture Academic Excellence-Merit Scholarships

#### Introduction

The PAH Solapur University has decided to introduce a reward system for girl students showing a high level of Merit during their academic program at PAH Solapur University. This reward system is in addition to the awards conferred during every year. It is aimed at bringing in an academic rigor among students and keeps them focused on their academic track.

This policy document details the various Scholarships that will be bestowed upon the students during their academic program and the framework to implement and disburse the Scholarship.

There will be three types of rewards for the students:

- i. Muli Shikva Samaj Ghadva
- ii. Earn and Learn
- iii. Departmental Research Fellowship
- iv. Sports Scholarship

## i. Muli Shikva Samaj Ghadva:

This consists of the Scholarships that will be given to girl students who are overall semester toppers of their batch and subject toppers in their class. The batch toppers of every class at senior and junior level during an academic year will be given a cash incentive.

#### ii. Earn and Learn:

The main objective of the scheme is to develop a student as a multifaceted personality with academic excellence and a commitment to an egalitarian society. India lives in her villages and to bridge the gap between rural Bharat and urban India, this scheme is basically undertaken for the benefit of students coming from the rural areas, who are economically backward, intelligent, and meritorious but cannot afford higher education, needy and financially hard pressed. It inculcates in the student the idea that no work is big or small and develops a work culture with the right aptitude. The list is created every semester for a program. This is a vision of keeping our youth gainfully employed as well as to contribute from civil society. This is a paradigm shift in the way we see higher education. This will make higher education accessible and available to the poor, meritorious and the marginalized.



### iii. Departmental Research Fellowship:

In view of the recent trends, thrust and emerging areas being introduced in research and considering the fact that the major number of University Students having mostly rural background and also due to limited access to the facilities at their disposal, it is observed that the University Students are denied access to facilities of upgrading their academic qualifications. It is also difficult to qualify themselves for the award of various scholarships / fellowships on national and state level which further tends to eliminate them from competition for good academic positions. It has therefore been decided to introduce a scheme to be known as "Departmental Research Fellowship".

## Eligibility:

A candidate having at least 55% marks at M.A. /M.Sc. / M.Com. Degree of the PAHSUS University is eligible to apply. The upper age limit will be 28 years relax able up to 5 years in the case of reserve categories, women and physical handicapped applicants. The selections will be made purely on the basis of merit.

#### General

- To facilitate speedy day-to-day working of the Research scholarship, the following power can be exercised by the Guides of Research student in concurrence with the Head of the Department.
- Sanctioning of leave when it is due.
- Approving of tours of Research Fellows for attending Symposia /Seminars/Conferences in India provided Fellow is presenting paper/papers which have been accepted and for attending workshop/training courses relevant to the research.
- Field work connected with the Research.
- Computation work.
- Consulting rare reference volumes in the nearest University / Research Institution library.
- The fellows may be given maximum 2 clock hours teaching / practical work in a week.

## **Operational Features:**

 After the end of every month a progress report in the prescribed performs will be sent to the Development Section for payment of scholarship.

- The report of the guide in monthly report should be Satisfactory / Good Progress
   / Very Good Progress otherwise the monthly scholarship will not be drawn.
- The researcher can avail by 30 days leave with scholarship in a year.
- The tenure of the scholarship will continue from the date of joining the scholarship award and the fellow will work as a full-time researcher during the summer and winter vacations.
- In extreme emergency such as accident severe illness the fellow will be granted
   1-month medical leave during the entire tenure of the scholarship.
- Applications for discontinuation of Scholarships will be submitted to the Vice-Chancellor with the recommendation of the Departmental Research Committee.
   Any problem in context of application of rules and procedural matters will be referred to the Hon. Vice-Chancellor for final decision.

## iv. Sports Scholarship:

University also provides the scholarship those students selected in National and International level sport festival. University provides the scholarship for sport students in order to encourage and support their talent in sports.

# Visvesvaraya PhD Scheme for Electronics & IT

Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India initiated "Visvesvaraya PhD Scheme for Electronics and IT" with an objective to enhance the number of PhDs in Electronics System Design & Manufacturing (ESDM) and IT/IT Enabled Services (IT/ITES) sectors in the country.

Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) approved the scheme in 2014 for a period of nine years with a total estimated cost of 466 crores (Rupees Four Hundred Sixty Six Crores Only)

#### Objectives:

- To enhance the number of PhDs in Electronics System Design & Manufacturing (ESDM) and IT/IT Enabled Services (IT/ITES) sectors in the country.
- Give thrust to R&D, create an innovative ecosystem and enhance India's competitiveness in these knowledge intensive sectors.
- To fulfil the commitments made in National Policy on Electronics (NPE 2012) and National Policy on Information Technology (NPIT 2012) which recommend to give special thrust on significantly increasing the number of PhDs in the country to enable India to compete globally in the coming decades, to develop an ecosystem of research, development and IP creation in these knowledge intensive sectors.
- To Support 1500 PhD Candidates including both Full-Time (500) and Part-Time (1000) in each of ESDM and IT/ITES sectors (Total: 3000 PhDs).
- The scheme is also expected to encourage working professionals and non-PhD faculty members to pursue PhD.

#### Salient features of the PhD Scheme are as follows:

- This Scheme provides 25% more fellowship amount than most of the other PhD Schemes.
- Part-time PhD candidates get one time incentive on completion of the PhD.
- Scheme also supports 200 Young Faculty Research Fellowships in the areas of ESDM and IT/ITES with the objective to retain and attract bright young faculty members in these sectors.

#### Support for Institution Under Scheme:

- "Visvesvaraya PhD Scheme" is an Institutional Scheme, where the PhD seats are allocated to the institutions and the institutes enroll the PhD candidates on these seats following their admission procedures.
- The support under the scheme will be provided to the institution granting the PhD degree and no direct funding support will be provided by Government of India to the PhD candidates or faculty members or to the departments in the supported institution. The institution will be responsible for



seeking financial support and for furnishing utilization certificates of the funds released and based on the scheme parameters, and as per conditions of the sanction of grant-in-aid.

The institutes are allocated the PhD seats for a particular Academic Year expecting the enrollment of PhD candidates on allocated seats in same Academic Year.

- The scheme also provides infrastructural grant of 5,00,000/- per Full Time PhD candidate to the academic institutions for creation/ up-gradation of laboratories etc. (excluding civil construction/ expansion of building). The support is provided @ 50% of the actual cost subject to a ceiling of 5 lakhs per Full Time PhD candidate under the scheme.
- Scheme provides Institutional Overhead of 25,000/- per year per Full Time PhD candidate for a maximum of five years to the academic institutions.
- Deserving non-Indian students at supported academic institution of the country can be provided support under "Visvesvaraya PhD Scheme for Electronics and IT". However, for any institution / university the number of such non-Indian students shall not be more than 10% of the Indian students (rounded off to nearest full number) supported under the scheme.
- List of institutions supported under the scheme as on date is available at the <u>link</u>
- Each institution supported under the scheme has nominated a nodal officer at the institute to coordinate with PhD Cell for matters related to the scheme.

#### Full Time PhD Candidates:

- The candidates would be enrolled at the supported institution under the scheme as per the procedural norms and 'Terms & Conditions' of that institution. Hence, the interested candidates are advised to contact the institution supported under the scheme.
- Candidates already registered under the scheme at the supported institutions are advised to contact nodal officer at their institution for any issues or query related to the scheme. The nodal officer in turn may contact PhD Cell in case further clarifications.
- Financial support provided to each Full Time PhD candidate is as mentioned below.
- Fellowship: 31,500/- per month (I & II year); 35,000/-(III to V year); revised to 38,750/- per month (I & II year); 43,750/-(III to V year).
- Annual Contingency Grant support of 30,000/- per year for consumables etc. For guidelines click here.
- Reimbursement of Rent for those Full Time PhD candidates who are not provided accommodation or choose not to avail the accommodation provided by the institution.
- The ceiling for Reimbursement of Rent would be 30%, 20%, and 10% of the fellowship amount as per the Government of India norms for class X, Y or Z cities respectively.
- Support for attending international conferences (Supports for 1000 conferences with an amount up
  to 50,000/- per conference). Any individual Full Time PhD candidate would be eligible to avail
  the support for attending a maximum of 2 conferences under this scheme. The list of conferences

### Part Time PhD Candidates:

- The candidates would be enrolled at the supported institution under the scheme as per the procedural norms and 'Terms & Conditions' of that institution. Hence, the interested candidates are advised to contact the institutions supported under the scheme.
- One time incentive of 2,50,000/- would be provided to Part Time PhD candidates on successful completion of the PhD.

### `'oung Faculty Research Fellowship(YFRF)



- As per guidelines of the scheme for Young Faculty Research Fellowship (YFRF), each institute supported under the scheme is eligible for award of 01 YFRF for each 05 Full Time PhD candidates, enrolled under the scheme.
- Since Visvesvaraya PhD Scheme is an institutional scheme, the institution forwards the nomination for awardee of YFRF as per eligibility to PhD Cell.

- Financial support provided to the YFRFs is as mentioned below:
  - Fellowship @ 20,000/- per month in addition to the regular income
