





As of date the survey of project affected households has been carried out using household schedules which covered 25% of the household in the project affected villages, viz. Aherwadi, Fatatewadi and Hotgi Station. The data has been analyzed using SPSS software and the tabulation scheme is ready for preparing the preliminary report. Various case studies also have been conducted for the selected households to bring</p>

out insides on the effectiveness of various welfare programs implemented by NTPC under its rehabilitation and resettlement programme. A workshop is to be conducted in the near future taking suitable time with the NTPC officials to share the preliminary findings of the Social Audit study. After this workshop taking the feedback and suggestions form the NTPC officials the study report will be finalized.
