The following deliberations have been made under the aforesaid academic collaboration between Finland Futures Research Centre (FFRC), Turku University, Turku, Finland and Centre for Foresight Studies (CFS) School of Social Sciences, Solapur University, Solapur, Maharashtra. I. International conference on "Futures of a Complex World"

The purpose of this academic visit was to participate in the international conference on "Futures of a Complex World" organized by the Finland Futures Research Centre

also had of the opinion that there could be possibility to start a new paper on Sustainable Development via virtual mode.

III. Organization of a Joint International Conference

Dr.Juha Kaskinen, Director (FFRC), Finland has in-principle agreed FFRC's participation in an International Conference to be organised by Solapur University as a official partner and assured overall cooperation. Prof.Ashok Kumar on behalf of Solapur University extended gratitude to the FFRC for providing necessary cooperation in particularly conference webpage designing and partial funding. It has also been decided that optimum participation of students will be taken through poster and paper presentations from both the institutes. Consequently, expertises from both the Universities will be used to pull key resource persons, funding sources, budget, itinerary plan and effective marketing. It has also been decided to the procedure of peer review of abstract; editorial board; post publication issues and so on. The conference will be organised during the month of September 2017. Prof.Kumar also summarized the funding status and thanked Vice Chancellor for granting Rs.5 lakh for the proposed conference.

IV Exploring new avenues for future collaboration between the two universities

To explore the avenues for future collaborations between the two universities there were extensive discussions with the key officials of University of Turku, Finland. Meetings with Vice Rector Mrs Dr.Rita Pyykko and International Liaison Officer Kirsi Korpela and FFRC faculty were quite constructive. Initially, there was a consensus to have student and teacher exchange in future. Meanwhile, it can also be possible to start online courses in collaboration with FFRC, University of Turku and scholarship for the few meritorious students who wish to peruse their PhD's in the University of Turku, Finland.

V. The proposed visit by Dr.Juha Kaskinen, Director (FFRC) at Solapur University

As decided by Dr.Juha Kaskinen, Director (FFRC) he will be visiting in the month of August 2017 to perform the following vital assignments:

- i) to sensitize students and teachers towards the advanced methods of Futures studies;
- to asses the mid-term group based final research projects completed by the students;
- iii) to suggest relevant methodological and contextual changes in the report; and

Memorandum of Understanding Between School of Social Sciences, Solapur University, Solapur, India and Finland Futures Research Centre, University of Turku, Finland

The School of Social Sciences (Solapur University, India) and Finland Futures Research Centre (University of Turku, Finland) believe that mutual benefits can be derived by bridging their two universities, achieving a closer relationship by linking the scholars, students and personnPel. This Memorandum of Understanding is aimed at initiating collaborative academic exchange between the two organizations and to promote excellence in teaching, research and extension activities in the discipline of Futures Studies. The areas identified are indicative and open for modification.

Article 1: Principle of Cooperation

The School of Social Sciences (Solapur University, India) and Finland Futures Research Centre (University of Turku, Finland) agree to develop their academic links under the principle of mutual understanding, mutual benefits, common interests and mutually complementary activities.

Article II: Areas on Cooperation

- 1. Introduction of *Executive M Phil in Forecasting Studies* with specialization in Rural, Human and Regional Development at School of Social Sciences, Solapur University:
 - The program shall be of duration one year and addressed to Mid-Career Professionals working in Government, Semi-Government, Corporate, Academic and Civil Society organizations. The course shall be offered in external mode with mandatory contact lectures in the form of both virtual and real class room sessions. Curriculum designing, evaluation standards, fee structure, faculty assistance, awarding of degrees and other operational details can be worked out on mutually amicable manner.
- 2. Undertaking joint Research, Consultancy and Training programs:

 Under this activity, joint projects shall be mobilized which shall be relevant to India and Finland through funding support from Governments, Corporations and Bilateral and Multilateral organizations in the areas of Policy Advocacy and Futures Studies. Exchanging faculty expertise in handling such assignments, sharing resources and responsibilities and other modalities shall be worked as things move ahead.
- Organizing Seminars, Workshops and Winter Schools:
 These activities shall be jointly organized in India to facilitate knowledge sharing on Futures Studies and Capacity Building among the upcoming scholars and

professionalsboth in India and the South Asian Countries. Resources and modalities for organizing such events shall be worked out in mutually convenient terms.

4. Development of Data Bank:

Under this activity, relevant themes and issues that are of interest and concern to both the countries shall be identified and a data archive will be developed to promote *state of art research* in Futures Studies which can be used by the students for academic research and by the planners and administrators for modeling and program implementation. The specific program under this activity shall be worked with mutual consultation.

5. Publications:

Joint publications on topical themes in the form of monographs, occasional papers and working papers shall be worked out involving faculty and students from both the countries.

6. The partners shall encourage any other activities that both organizations agree to be of mutual benefit.

7. All these activities will be housed in the Centre for Development and Forecasting Studies (CDFS) under the aegis of the School of Social Sciences, Solapur University, Solapur, India.

8. For better Synergy and Coordination, the CDFS shall constitute one Advisory Board and a Steering Committee with defined functions and responsibilities and the activities shall be institutionalized. The members to these bodies shall be drawn from both the countries after detailed consultations.

Article III: Duration and Termination of the Agreement

- 1. This MOU is effective as of the date of signature by each participating university.
- 2. This MOU may be amended at any time as indicated by written mutual consent.
- 3. This MOU may be terminated by either organization by the provision of written notice of termination not less than six months prior to the desired termination date. However, both universities agree that all continuing obligation to students, staff, funding bodies or other entities are met in full subsequent to the notice of termination.
