Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

Subject: Sponsoring Schedule Caste Candidates belonging to the State of Maharashtra, for the coaching of MPSC and IBPS Examinations.

This Memorandum of Understanding is executed on 17th August 2023 at Pune, between Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Research and Training Institute, Pune, an autonomous organization of the Department of Social Justice & Special Assistance, Government of Maharashtra, located at 28, Queen's Garden, Camp, Pune, (hereinafter referred to as BARTI), and Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University. Referred to as BARTI and Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University.

WHEREAS

BARTI has decided to provide financial support to the University for Conduct of coaching classes for various competitive examinations for the students belonging to Scheduled Caste Community.

Now this Memorandum of Understanding witnesses that:

BARTI shall offer to the University 50 students for MPSC and 150 students for Banking (IBPS) from SC community for conducting coaching classes. Out of total admitted students, 30% students will be Female and 4% students will be Physical Handicap (Divyang).

The eligibility criteria for candidates, norms for selection of students for the above coaching class, item-wise approximate expenses shall be as under:

- 1. Duration of Coaching Class: One year for MPSC
 : Six months for Banking (IBPS)
- 2. Number of students to be admitted in batch = 50 students for MPSC and 150 students for IBPS in a year.
- 3. Eligibility criteria for candidates for selection in coaching class:
 - (i) Educational qualification: As prescribed by above said competitive exams.
 - (ii) Candidate should be domicile of Maharashtra State
 - (iii) Candidate should belong to Scheduled Caste.
- 4 Screening test:

Selection of candidates for the coaching classes will be made through screening test to be conducted by the Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University.

- Syllabus and session plan:
 All Syllabus of above-mentioned exams will be covered during the coaching classes.
- 6. Financial Support:

6.A Financial support in the form of grant for the coaching class for duration of one year for MPSC for a batch of 50 students under various heads shall be:

However, the Director General, BARTI reserves his right to change the above-mentioned item-wise estimated expenditure. This can be done to accommodate the deviation/change in item wise actual expenses to be incurred by the University.

7. Stipend to students:


Month wise Stipend @ Rs. 4,000/- per month per student shall be paid only to the students belonging to Scheduled Caste having attendance of 75% and above decided by Director, Competitive Examination Centre, University and Sanctioned by Director General, BARTI, Pune

- (Month wise Stipend Rs. 4,000/- per month per student shall be paid only to the residential students at university hostels and the Rs. 6000/- stipend shall be paid to students which don't get hostel facility by the university.
- Stipend shall be paid if student having attendance of 75% and above.)
- 8. The students will also be eligible for Reference Books-kit and amount deposited to students account by DBT.


RESPONSIBILITIES OF BARTI

- I. BARTI shall release 40% funds against the sanction accorded at the time of execution of MoU and 40% during midterm of the course and remaining 20% fund will be released after completion of the course.
- II. BARTI will have the right to inspect the infrastructure facilities provided by the university periodically. University shall take action on the observation/suggestions made by BARTI on these coaching classes.

- III. BARTI will have the right to inspect the books of accounts related to coaching classes including the vouchers, cashbook, bills, ledgers etc., through its officers or the designated for the purpose.
- IV. BARTI shall have full powers to review the programme / courses and if at any time, the BARTI comes to the conclusion that the course is not being conducted satisfactory, BARTI shall discontinue the courses without calling for the explanation of the University and the university shall not be entitled to any payment towards damages or otherwise for their having invested any money in providing the infrastructures, etc.
- V. Director General, BARTI reserve his right to amend / alter this MoU at any time.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE UNIVERSTY

The above coaching classes shall be conducted at University. During the period mutually agreed upon by the parties.

- I. University shall issue an advertisement in local newspapers for inviting applications from eligible candidates and conduct screening test for selection of candidates for the coaching class at their cost within the budget provided for.
- II. Filled-in application shall be received from the candidates by the University shall scrutinize the applications and conduct the screening test at the designated centers. The norms and eligibility criteria for selection of students laid down by BARTI shall be followed by the University.
- III. University shall submit the list of selected candidates for coaching class within a week from the date of selection of candidates.
- IV. University Shall obtain undertaking from the selected candidates, to the effect, that they will attend the classes regularly and will ensure minimum 75 per cent attendance during the coaching period.

University shall engage qualified, experienced and competent resource persons as faculty for coaching classes. The list of such persons will be furnished to BARTI.

University shall provide infrastructure such as classrooms to accommodate 50 or more students in each classroom with proper ventilation, separate toilet facilities for and boys and proper lights, fans, etc. in the rooms free of cost.


University shall make efforts to provide residential facilities in the hostel for the students selected for coaching classes of above-mentioned competitive exams. University shall also make efforts to provide mess facility either through its management or by a private caterer and in that case, expenses will be recovered directly from the students or from the stipend paid to the students.

- VIII. University shall make library and reading room facilities with internet, periodical, journals, magazines, newspapers, and latest publications on the areas/topics of the respective competitive examinations available to the selected students.
- IX. University shall introduce proper supervision of residential and mess facilities in the hostel and also cleanliness in the hostel.
- X. University shall provide digital classroom with interactive board to the students.
- XI. Classes for the aforesaid course shall be conducted by the University in conformity with contents and syllabus prescribed by the BARTI.

- XII. University shall prepare study material through its academic faculty or through resource persons engaged in taking the sessions in the coaching classes form the budget provided for the sessions in the coaching classes form the budget
- XIII. University will invite specialists form different fields to share their experience, approaches and strategies for personality development of the selected students.
- XIV. University will conduct monthly test and submit progress report of all students every month by 10th of the succeeding month by email to BARTI (in the format prescribed by BARTI).
- XV. University will credit the amount of stipend to the Savings Bank Accounts with commercial banks of the students through NEET/RTGS (DBT) on monthly basis and send the record of the payment along with attendance to BARTI by 7th of the succeeding month.
- XVI. University will maintain item-wise accounts for the expenditure on various components. It will submit Xerox copies of the bills duly certified by the competent authority, dealing with these accounts in the university, in case demanded by BARTI.
- XVII. University shall monitor quality of the programs through persons appointed by it for this purpose.
- XVIII. University will ensure that students continue the coaching throughout the year and for that, the University will arrange for classes discussions for moral supporting, counseling etc. to the students.
- XIX. After completion of the Training Programme, a Report with the following documents must be submitted by the University to the BARTI.
 - Course Completion Report.
 - Test Results
 - Individual Report/Growth Report of each candidate
 - Improvement Report of each candidate after joining the training program.
- XX. The above said financial grant will be applicable only if the students continue for whole year.
- XXI. After completion of MoU period the contingency (Stationary, Furniture, Computers, Laptops) and Non-recurring library books, News Papers, Journal, Magazines etc. shall be handed over to Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur and it shall be treated as property of Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur. So that other students can get benefits of these.
- XXII. In case of any dispute arising out of this MoU shall be first discussed between the Direct of General, BARTI and The Vice-Chancellor of this University and the decision taken after such discussion shall be binding on both the parties.

XXIII. Any dispute will be within the jurisdiction of the Court in Pune city only.

This MOU shall be valid till / /2024 and can be renewed for a further period of one yearby mutual consent.






