NMK Agro Farms Pvt. Ltd, Tal.- Barshi, Dist.-Solapur, having its registered office Gat no 1399/1 +1/2, Plot no 45, Latur Road, Tal.-Barshi, Dist.-Solapur Pin Code-413401 herein represented by its Directors- Mr. Ravindra Navnath Kaspate, Mr. Navanath Malhari Kaspate,

(Hereinafter referred as 'Second Party' or 'Party Two', which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors in-office administrators and assignees.

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

WHEREAS

Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University Solapur

Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur was established in 2004 as State owned University in Solapur with more than 11 school at its campus. These school have Post graduate courses with skill-based component.

NMK Agro Farms Pvt. Ltd, Tal.- Barshi, Solapur, [hereinafter referred to as Party Two] STARTUP have developed More than 3000 Varieties of NMK Custard Apple. Who is World's largest variety holders for Custard Apple.



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First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities in the areas of strengthened industry-academia interaction. The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Technical Education, Innovation, Entrepreneurship, Research and problem solving for industries. Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest.

Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur & its Incubation Center and NMK Agro Farms Pvt. Ltd, Tal.- Barshi, Solapur enter a Memorandum of Understanding to play a catalytic role to promote innovation, provide support for research, to bridge the gap in skill development and for entrepreneurship development in the region.

CLAUSE 1 AREA OF COLLABORATION

- 1.1 Support Innovation by effective exchange of Researchers knowledge & other common resources, arranging field visits etc.
- 1.2 To strive for Innovation Driven Entrepreneurship & Technology Transfer Culture amongst Stake holders.
- 1.3 To organize seminar, workshop, Agri startup Camp for new Innovation driven Entrepreneurship.
- 1.4 Sharing common facility for the budding innovators and entrepreneurs such as Patent Licensing for Custard Apple, Testing facilities & other resources.

CLAUSE 2 CO-OPERATION

2.1 Both Parties are willing to unite by common interests and objectives mentioned under clause 1 and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the campuses of **both parties**.



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- 2.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of Second Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry and society.
- 2.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds, and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The terms of **Definitive Documents** shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.
 - 2.4 To achieve these goals, Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur & its Incubation Center and NMK Agro Farms Pvt. Ltd, Tal.-Barshi, Solapur will, insofar as the means of each allow:
 - To support and act as catalyst in the establishment of early-stage Startups by Mentoring and Facilitating Entrepreneurs, to convert their innovative ideas into commercially viable enterprise resources.
 - 2. Promote institutional exchanges through Faculty, Staff and Students of the partner industries to participate in a variety of research and professional development activities.
 - 3. Organize Seminars / Symposia / Conferences/Workshops/Short Term Courses and meetings on research, innovation, IPR and start up and technical education and related issues.
 - 4. Promote appropriate joint research projects and joint courses of study, with particular emphasis on funded projects.
 - 5. Carry out joint research programs to deepen the analysis and understanding of science and technology of the respective institutions.
 - 6. Exchange information pertaining to developments in research at each institution.
 - 2.5 Both Parties can jointly arrange workshop/seminars/bootcamp/idea validation camp for Students, Faculties & Start-ups in the field of agriculture &

CLAUSE 3 SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 3.1 The budding graduates from the institutions is looking forward to play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge and result into betterment of quality of community living and industry performance.
- 3.2 Efforts of the MOU will be for creating a long term positive behavioral change in students, staff of institute and make it easy to work in collaboration with industry by engaging them in solving real life problems.



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- 3.3 First Party shall support Second Party by tools, processes, networking, policies for efficient innovation, incubation along with industry readiness.
- 3.4 Guest Lectures: First Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the second Party on the technology trends and inhouse requirements, as and when requested by Second Party, and as per mutual administrative convenience between two parties.
- 3.5 Faculty Development Programs and consultancy: First Party to help or facilitate in training the Faculties of Second Party for imparting industrial exposure/ training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available. Second Party shall create consultancy opportunities for deserving faculties of First Party

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CLAUSE 4 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 4.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel (the principle which precludes a person from asserting something contrary to what is implied by a previous action or statement of that person or by a previous pertinent judicial determination) or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.
- 4.2 Should any faculty collaboration result in any potential for intellectual property, the parties will immediately meet through designated representatives and seek an equitable and fair understanding as to ownership and other property interests that may arise. Any such discussions will always strive to preserve a harmonious and continuing relationship between the parties.

CLAUSE 5 IMPLEMENTATION METHODOLOGY

- 5.1 This Memorandum of Understanding will be identified as the parent document of any program agreement executed between the Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur & its Incubation Center and NMK Agro Farms Pvt. Ltd, Tal.- Barshi, Dist.-Solapur. No modification, alteration or amendment of this Agreement will be effective unless in writing and signed by both the Parties. Further agreements concerning any program will provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and will not become effective until they have been put down in writing and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties. The scope of the activities under this agreement will be determined by the funds regularly available at both organizations for the types of collaboration undertaken and by financial assistance as may be obtained by either institution from external sources.
- 5.2 This Memorandum is not a contract. This Memorandum serves only as a statement of the general intention and is not intended to be legally binding nor to be construed as an agreement on any matters mentioned. No oral agreement or conduct of the institutions (including partial performance) in respect of matters stated in this Memorandum shall be deemed to impose any obligation or liability on either Party. This Memorandum is not intended to constitute, create, give effect to, or otherwise form a joint venture, or other



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business entity of any kind. Neither Party shall act as an agent for, or $part_{ner}$ of, the other Party. There are neither any rights nor obligations of the Parties established under this Memorandum.

CLAUSE 6 -LOGO USAGE AND RECOGNITION

- At all functions/literature related to this MOU activities, associated party logos will be displayed with equal prominence. Both parties' logos usage will be permitted for such designs. Both action committee members will have to approve (in writing) any design to be printed or if any mention about this MOU is done anywhere by either party.
- 6.2 All publications resulting from the collaboration between the two partners must give recognition to the Memorandum. Likewise, the Memorandum must also be mentioned in all courses and formal presentations that result from collaboration under the terms hereof.

CLAUSE 7 CONSIDERATION AND ADMINISTRATIVE COST

- 7.1 The parties understand that they are proceeding at their own risk and they understand that costs regarding the subject matter under this Memorandum are to be paid for by the Party who incurs the cost. Nothing contained in this Memorandum is to be construed as providing for the sharing of profits or losses arising out of the efforts of either or both Parties. Neither Party will be liable to the other for any costs, expenses, risks, or liabilities arising out of the other Parties efforts in connection with this Memorandum.
- 7.2 As a part of this MOU, parties may subscribe separately to services of other party upon paying mutually agreeable cost. All such services and their scope of operation including administrative cost shall get defined separately as and when necessary upon acceptance by both parties.
- 7.3 Terms of reference with respect to the cost of the planned activities to be done shall be based on scope and size of the activity, terms of payment, essential logistics and shall be decided explicitly ahead of the activity, on case-to-case basis and through the mutual consent.

CLAUSE 8 VALIDITY AND CONFIDENTIALITY



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- 8.1 Upon approval by parties, this Memorandum will remain in effect for a period of Three (3) years unless terminated earlier by either institution. Such termination by one institution shall be affected by giving the other institution at least six (6) months advance written notice of its intention to terminate. Termination will be without penalty. If this Memorandum is terminated, neither Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur & its Incubation Center nor NMK Agro Farms Pvt. Ltd, Tal.- Barshi, Dist.-Solapur will be liable to the other for any monetary or other losses which may result.
- 8.2 During the tenure of the agreement and five years thereafter both parties undertake on its behalf and on behalf of its subcontractors/employees/representatives/associates/consultant(s) to maintain strict confidentiality of the information related to business related works and prevent disclosure thereof, of all the information and data exchanged/generated pertaining to work under this agreement for any purposes other than in accordance with the agreement. In accordance to maintenance of confidentiality and shall remain in force for next FIVE years from the date of its signing.
- 8.3 Notwithstanding the above, the period of this cooperation will, if necessary, be extended with consent in writing from the Parties.

CLAUSE 9 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

9.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent entities working independently to achieve own objectives, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

CLAUSE 10 FORCE MAJEURE, COMPLIANCE AND PRESS RELEASE

10.1 Neither party shall be held responsible for non-fulfillment of their respective responsibilities and obligations stated under CLAUSE 3 Scope of MOU of this agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such



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as but not limited to Acts of God, war, flood, earthquakes, strike, lockouts, epidemics, riots, civil commotion, etc. provided on the occurrence and cessation of any such events, the party affected thereby shall give a notice in writing to the other party within one month of such occurrence or cessation. If the force-majeure conditions continue beyond six months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.

- 10.2 Both parties agree to comply with all national, state, and local rules, regulations, executive orders, laws, and policies for bidding unlawful discrimination to which Institution is subject.
- 10.3 The institutions intend to discuss with each other press releases in connection with this Memorandum prior to publication of any press release.

CLAUSE 11 ASSIGNMENT OF THE AGREEMENT AND JURISDICTION

- 11.1 The rights and/or liabilities arising to any party to this agreement shall not be assigned except with the written consent of the other party and subject to such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.
- 11.2 **Governing laws and arbitration:** The MOU shall be construed and governed by the laws of India. Any controversy or claim arising out of or divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU or breach thereof shall be resolved/settled by arbitration, to be held in Mumbai as in accordance with the rules of the arbitration and conciliation Act 1996.

CLAUSE 12 AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT

No amendment or modification of this agreement shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this agreement. The modifications/changes shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed, unless otherwise agreed to.



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All 12 clauses, including their subclauses are agreed and executed by Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University and its Incubation Center and NMK Agro Farms Pyt. Ltd, Tal.- Barshi, Dist.-Solapur in duplicate copies, each of which will be deemed an original. In witness whereof both parties hereto have signed this agreement on the day, month and year mentioned hereinbefore and executed as an agreement.

Note:

- Second Party has highlighted broad scope of possible initiatives. Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur & its Incubation Center can choose & shortlist initiatives which are relevant & further specific details can be worked out with both the
- II. Punyashlok Ahilyadevi Holkar Solapur University, Solapur & its Incubation Center can evolve its calendar of activities considering its focus areas. Based on this calendar party 2 can work out all further details for on-ground execution.
- III. Financial details amongst the two parties can be worked out separately as per the predefined scope of any such activity.
- IV. Second Party does not invest in any startups by way of equity hence the ownership of the startup rests with the promoter of the Startup. Similarly, the ownership of any such innovation can rest with Student /Faculty /Mentor / investor or the academic institution
- V. Second Party does not have its own technologies; however, its role is limited to facilitate any such possible technology transfer in the future.
- VI. Respective academic institution will have to arrange for the space & facilities for the Incubator / E - Cell or Innovation Cell at their campus. It can generate surplus amounts while conducting any activity as per its mandate and any such surplus generated is then once again deployed back for the such cause - Innovation - Incubation - Entrepreneurship for which this section 8 Company is established. Second Party cannot distribute any dividend to its stakeholders.

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made on this 07th of August 2018 at Sahyadri Guest House, Valkeshwar, Malabar Hill, Mumbai Maharashtra (INDIA).

BETWEEN

THE MAHARASHTRA UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, NASHIK a body corporate established under section 3 of the 'Maharashtra University of Health Sciences Act, 1998' (Maharashtra Act No. X of 1999) having its head office at Dindori Road, Mhasrul, Nashik-422 004, Maharashtra State, India, hereinafter referred to as "MUHS", represented by Dr. Kalidas Chavan, aged 47 years working as Registrar (which expression shall unless the meaning or context otherwise requires shall mean and include its successors and assigns) of the First Part;

AND

SOLAPUR UNIVERSITY, SOLAPUR Established in 2004, Non Agricultural State University, having its registered office at Kegaon, Solapur, Pune National Highway, Solapur- 413 255 hereinafter referred to as "SU" represented by Dr. Ganesh R. Manza, aged adult working as Registrar (which expression shall unless the meaning or context otherwise requires shall mean and include its successors and assigns) of the Other Part;

"MUHS" and "SU" are hereinafter also referred to individually as "Party" depending on reference and collectively as "Parties".

WHEREAS, it is the objective of the MUHS to disseminate, create and preserve knowledge and understanding by teaching, research, extension and service and by effective demonstration and influence of its corporate life on society;

AND WHEREAS, the MUHS has power to co-operate or collaborate with any other University, institution, authority or organisation for research and advisory services and for such purposes to enter into appropriate arrangement with other Universities, institutions, authorities or organisations to conduct certain courses as the situation may demand;

AND WHEREAS, the MUHS has power to provide for the training and quality improvement of teachers and non-teaching employees;

AND WHEREAS, to achieve this goal and objective it is decided to collaborate with the renowned and reputed foreign Universities, institutions and organisations of health sciences for training of faculties and students of affiliated health sciences colleges / recognised institutes by means of teachers (faculty) and students exchange programmes, research programmes and conferences etc.;

AND WHEREAS the MUHS and SU are discussing a potential for association between themselves for establishing collaboration in the field of training of faculty and students by adopting and designing their exchange programme;

AND WHEREAS the goal of this collaboration is to foster cooperation and facilitate advancement of knowledge, skill and ideas for betterment of health of the society and common man;

AND WHEREAS it is agreed by mutual discussion between MUHS and SU to establish a formal collaboration;

AND WHEREAS, the parties hereto agreed that detailed terms and conditions guiding the activities identified above shall be designed and formulated separately through mutual discussion:

AND WHEREAS, the parties, hereto are desirous to enter into a formal Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) of collaboration, in writing;

NOW THEREFORE, THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSETH AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND AMONG THE PARTIES HERETO, AS UNDER:

1. OBJECTIVES:-

- a) MUHS and SU will encourage direct contact and cooperation between faculty members, staff and students of the MUHS, affiliated colleges and recognised institutions of the MUHS and SU;
- b) To Exchange of invitations of lectures, seminars, workshops, conferences, symposia and other academic programmes;

c) To Exchange of faculty members and students for study and teaching and research;

- d) To start joint research activities, publications, library and data exchange;
- e) Any other specific academic activity related with study, teaching and research designed and mutually agreed between the parties.
- 2. Both the parties will be entered into separate and specific written agreement to govern any specific activity to be initiated to achieve the objectives mentioned above. The terms and conditions of such agreement will be determined separately by mutual discussion and consent of both the parties. Such agreement shall come into effect from the date of signing of the detailed and specific MoU.

3. STATUS:-

This MoU is not intended to be legally binding and no legal rights or obligations shall arise as a result of its terms except that clause 4 to 9 below shall be binding. It is the intension that a formal, legally binding agreement will be entered into between the parties to govern arrangements between them in respect of each specific activity mentioned in the objectives of this MoU.

4. COSTS:-

Each party shall bear its own costs and expenses in fulfilling this MoU.

5. INFORMATION SHARING AND CONFIDENTIALITY:-

- a) Each party shall keep secret all confidential information belonging to the other party, which is shared between them, and all shared information shall only be used for the purpose of fulfilling this MoU. This obligation to keep secret will not apply to information that a party is required by law or a competent court or other appropriate authority to disclose. However, this obligation will be continued after termination of MoU.
- b) Each party will ensure that any publicity is accurate and not misleading and does not contain reference to the other party (including name and logo) without its prior written consent.

6. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY:-

Unless and otherwise agreed in writing in relation to specific project or academic activities, all intellectual property belonging to a party providing it to other party, on or after the date of this MoU shall remain the property of the party providing it. Any intellectual property rights created in the course of activities anticipated by this MoU shall vest in the party which or whose employee created them.

7. REGULATORY:-

- a) Neither party will treat any person or group of person less favourably than other or make any discrimination on the grounds of race, religion, caste, ethnic belief, sex, disability, nationality colour or marital status.
- b) Each party will comply with all applicable laws and regulations of INDIA. Where there is difference of provision is arises in any law or regulation of the country of any party, such difference shall be settled amicably by mutual discussion and necessary amendment to that effect shall be carried out separately.

8. TERM, EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT:-

This MoU shall become effective from the date of its signing by the representatives of both the parties and shall be remained inforce for the period of FIVE years from the date of its signing. Either party shall terminate this MoU by serving written notice on the registered address of other party and it shall be treated as terminated after the notice period or after completion of any undergoing collaborative programme, as the case may be. The notice period shall not be less than 30 clear days. In such situation both the parties shall act reasonably, that any action or omission of any party shall not affects the good reputation of other party.




