**RAJARSHI SHAHU MAHARAJ GUNAVATTA SCHOLARSHIP TO 100
STUDENTS BELONGING TO SCHEDULED CASTES FOR EDUCATION IN
RENOWNED EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN THE COUNTRY**

SECOND TIME ADVERTISEMENT

The Government of Maharashtra vide its Resolution dated 11th June, 2003 and 5th August, 2004 have decided to give “Rajarshi Shahu Maharaj Gunavatta Scholarship” to 100 students belonging to Scheduled Castes to undertake studies in renowned educational institutions in the country. In accordance with the said decision applications are called for scholarship to undertake education in the renowned educational institutions in the country from the students who have secured admission during the academic year 2006-2007 to the courses in specified universities.

The applicants shall fulfill the following terms and conditions.

- 1) The student should belong to Scheduled Caste community.
- 2) The student should be the permanent resident of Maharashtra.
- 3) The annual income of the parents of the student shall not exceed Rs.2.50 lakhs. (Rupees Two lakhs Fifty thousand only Certificate from the competent authority is required).
- 4) Minimum 60% Marks at 12th Standard Exam. for Graduation course and Minimum 55% Marks at Graduation level for Post Graduation course are required.
- 5) The said scholarship is offered to the students belonging to Scheduled Castes who have already secured admissions to the specified courses in the country as mentioned below :
 - (a) The students who have secured admission for MBA through CAT at I.I.M Institute Ahmedabad, Kolkata, Bangalore, Lucknow, Indore, Kozhikode (Kerala) and Indian Business School, Hyderabad or A+ Business Schools as classified by the Business India or equivalent organization/institution.
 - (b) Admissions secured through Joint Entrance Examinations to I.I.T at Mumbai, Delhi, Guwahati, Kharagpur, Chennai, Roorki, Kanpur
 - (c) Admission secured at All India Institute of Medical Science, New Delhi. Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore and Birla Institute of Technology, Pilani, Rajasthan. VJTI, Mumbai. PIET, Pune. VICT, Mumbai, National Institute of Agricultural Management, Hyderabad, Forest Research Institute, Deharadun
 - (d) Admission secured through All India Entrance Examination at Allahabad, Bhopal, Kalikat, Hamidpur, Jaipur, Jalandhar, Kurukshetra, Nagpur, Rourkela, Silachal, Surat, Surathkal, Warangal.

- 6) Application should be made in the prescribed form only, which are available free of cost at Director of Social Welfare, Maharashtra State, Pune (Education Branch).
Divisional Social Welfare Officer of the concerned Division / Special District Social Welfare Officer of the concerned District.
